Construction Site Safety Technician (CSST) training is designed to prepare an individual to assume the responsibility of construction site coordination and project safety. This 120 hour course complies with OSHA requirements in onsite management and safety technology. It covers the essentials of construction site safety, including human relations, effective safety training, OSHA, inspection, audits, observation, accident investigations, recordkeeping, fall protection, evacuations, and uncommon leadership.

The CSST course reviews 37 safety related topics in two parts. First, the curriculum discusses the safety professional's role. For example, lessons cover field safety and on-the-job specifics for different crafts in order for the craft professional to expertly handle a multitude of situations. Second, the curriculum teaches management and system supervisory roles, like safety technology, risk assessment and emergency action procedures.
